In deciding whether a particular Department / Establishment/ Organization an Industrial, Commercial or Trading Organizations (i.e. other than those doing work of Secretariat nature) the decision may be taken by the respective Ministry / Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi.

The date of Holidays for the Muslim Festivals may be changed on sighting of the Moon and decision to be taken by the CGEWCC, Kolkata based on the decision of the State Government in respect of Idu'l Fitr, Idu'l Zoha[Id -Uz-Zuha(Bakrid)], Muharram and Id -e - Milad.
